Sub: Providing benefit of waiver from scanning and re-examination process to compliant non-AEO exporters

Greetings from Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

At the outset, we appreciate and applaud the introduction of self-sealing of cargo and self-certification of goods exported from Mundra Port. Such initiatives are in line with the government's efforts to improve Ease of Doing Business, as they make the process of exports simpler, faster and more efficient.

Sir, as part of this initiative, the exporters having "Authorised Economic Operator" status have been exempted from scanning and re-examination of their self-sealed cargo exported through your port. However, it has come to our notice that many genuine exporters who are unable to obtain the AEO status immediately due to some technical reasons and therefore they are unable to avail the benefit of the exemption even though they have a 100% compliant track record. For e.g. in the case of newly established companies, criteria such as net worth may be difficult to achieve as they are in the initial stages of operation.

We are of the opinion that the spirit and objective of the AEO scheme is to encourage exporters to be self-compliant, promote self-certification and self-sealing amongst the exporters and ultimately give the benefit of faster process to such compliant exporters. While we do not in any way recommend leniency in laws for non-compliant exporters, it is necessary at the same time that the genuine exporters are not subjected to the burden of complex and time-consuming procedures. It is with this objective in mind that we suggest that the benefit of this scheme should be made available also to the new exporters with a good compliant track record. We are enclosing herewith the details of one such case of Satyesh BrineChem Pvt. Ltd. for your perusal.

We look forward to your positive intervention in the above matter, in the larger interest of exporters.

Apropos the captioned subject, we, M/s. Satyesh Brinechen Private Limited, Ahmedabad, have set up a green field manufacturing facility for the production of Industrial Salt and Liquid Bromine at Greater Rann of Kutch, Near Hajipir, Taluka Bhuj, District Kutch-370605, (Gujarat).

The multiple applications of Liquid Bromine have led to a remarkable growth in the global market. In regard to this, a part of the Bromine will be sold in the domestic market and majority will be exported.

We have recently commenced the production of Liquid Bromine and majority of the produce is exported. To avoid the delay in the customs clearances for serving our International Clients on a timely and efficient basis, we have applied to the Deputy Commissioner (DE/RMS), Officer of the Principal Commissioner of Customs, requesting them for waiver off scanning and re-examination of our self-sealing cargo — Liquid Bromine exported in our own SOC ISO Tanks through Mundra Port on account of its precarious quality. We further inform that repeated or prolonged exposure of Bromine may cause acute and chronic health effects.

In response to our request letter, we were directed by the Deputy Commissioner to produce the "Authorised Economic Operator (AEO) Status", vide their letter VIII/48-15/DE/RMS/Misc./18-19/8562 dated 25th February, 2019. In terms of their direction, we had applied for AEO status, however, the same was rejected on account of the negative net worth in Financial Year 2016-17, the Company being in the initial years of operation. To this we inform that we are positive that our Company's Net worth will be positive for the next year and accordingly, we will be able to apply for the AEO status in next year.

We have also presented the aforesaid matter with Additional Director General (RMCC) ICEGATE, Mumbai, as the Mundra Port lies under their jurisdiction, but with resentment we hereby inform that there is no response from their good office, till date.

In this regard, we humbly request your good office to look into the matter and provide us your valuable support in representing our request with the respective authorities for availing the waiver off the requirement of scanning and re-examination of SOC ISO Tank Containers to avoid the delay in the customs clearances and thereby promoting the foreign export. We will be obliged to receive your support in this regard.

Thanking you in anticipation of your prompt positive action.
