Sub: CEPI Calculation

Respected Sir,

Greetings from the Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry (GCCI).

In connection with above subject, we would like to have some suggestion for calculation of CEPI score as follows.

- Fresh sampling may be carried out in Nov / Dec 2022 in all the CEPI areas for calculation of new CEPI score.
- Joint meeting of CPCB, GPCB and concerned stake holders i.e., GCCI/Industries Associations/ CETP operators may be held for fixing sampling locations and parameters. After fixing the sampling locations and parameters, GPCB/CPCB may initiate sampling in CEPI areas through third party.
- Stake holder may remain present during sampling. Stake holder may be permitted to collect counter sample of each sampling and analysed at NABL accredited Laboratory.
- CEPI score may be calculated jointly by CPCB, GPCB and concerned stake holder. Suggestions
 from stake holder may be consider at the time of calculation/finalization of CEPI score. It shall
 be published only after mutually agreed by all three agencies i.e. CPCB, GPCB and stake
 holder.
- CEPI Score calculated based on sampling carried out by GPCB in post monsoon of 2019 may also considered till new score derived after fresh sampling.
- Till new CEPI score derives, permission may be given to new industry/expansion of existing industry in area where CETP is complying and meeting with prescribed outlet norms.

We kindly request you to consider our presentation for calculation of CEPI score.
